

# Ohioans challenged to follow Mother Teresa's example

ARCHDIOCESE — The death of Mother Teresa has had a profound and varied impact on many persons throughout the world. Locally, reaction was immediate and heartfelt.

Within days, volunteers from various Cincinnati musical organizations had joined forces to plan an orchestra concert in honor of both the Missionaries of Charity foundress and the late Princess Diana.

Jay Meetze, who originated the idea, is an orchestral conducting master's degree candidate at the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, and he said, "I have always admired Princess Diana and Mother Teresa for the volunteer work which both of these women embraced. Their deaths have left a great

void, and I wanted to pay tribute to them in the best way I know how."

The concert is scheduled for Tuesday, Sept. 23, at 8 p.m. at St. Monica-St. George Church in Cincinnati. A free will donation will be accepted; a \$10 per person contribution is encouraged. All proceeds from the concert will benefit the AIDS volunteers of Cincinnati.
